Minister: The grace of our Lord (+) Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.


Congregation: And also with you.

SECOND LESSON

1 JOHN 5:5-12

The three Persons of the Trinity work together to achieve our salvation.

Who is the one who overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God. ⁶ This is the one who came by water and blood: Jesus Christ. He did not come by the water alone but by the water and by the blood. The Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. ⁷ In fact, there are three that testify: ⁸ the Spirit, the water, and the blood, and these three are one.

⁹ If we accept the testimony of people, God's testimony is even greater, because it is the testimony that God gave about his Son. ¹⁰ The one who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in him, but the one who does not believe has made God out to be a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God gave about his Son. ¹¹ This is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. ¹² The one who has the Son has life. The one who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

Jesus teaches the saving love of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. They work as one God with one mind and one goal: our eternal good.

"I still have many things to tell you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³ But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. For he will not speak on his own, but whatever he hears he will speak. He will also declare to you what is to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵ Everything the Father has is mine. This is why I said that he takes from what is mine and will declare it to you."

Sermon

TEXT: Titus 3:4-7

THEME: The Trinity Recreates Reality

But when the kindness and love of God our Savior toward mankind appeared, ⁵ he saved us—not by righteous works that we did ourselves, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and the renewal by the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom he poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, ⁷ so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs in keeping with the hope of eternal life.

PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

M: Triune God, you are the one eternal God, whose name we praise forever. C: Amen.


